




**Figure 1. Safe operating area**




**Figure 2. Thermal impedance**




**Figure 3. Output characteristics**




**Figure 4. Transfer characteristics**









**Figure 5. Gate charge vs gate-source voltage**




**Figure 6. Static drain-source on-resistance**

**Figure 12. Normalized V<sub>(BR)DSS</sub> vs temperature**


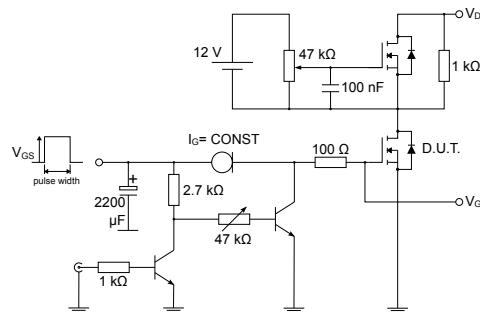

**Figure 13.** Test circuit for resistive load switching times



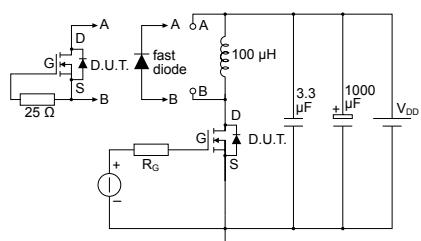

**Figure 14.** Test circuit for gate charge behavior



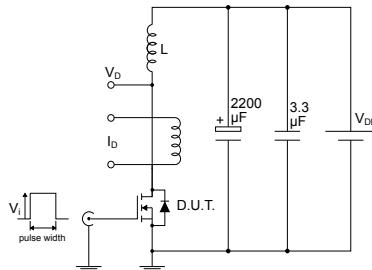

**Figure 15.** Test circuit for inductive load switching and diode recovery times





**Figure 16.** Unclamped inductive load test circuit





**Figure 18.** Switching time waveform



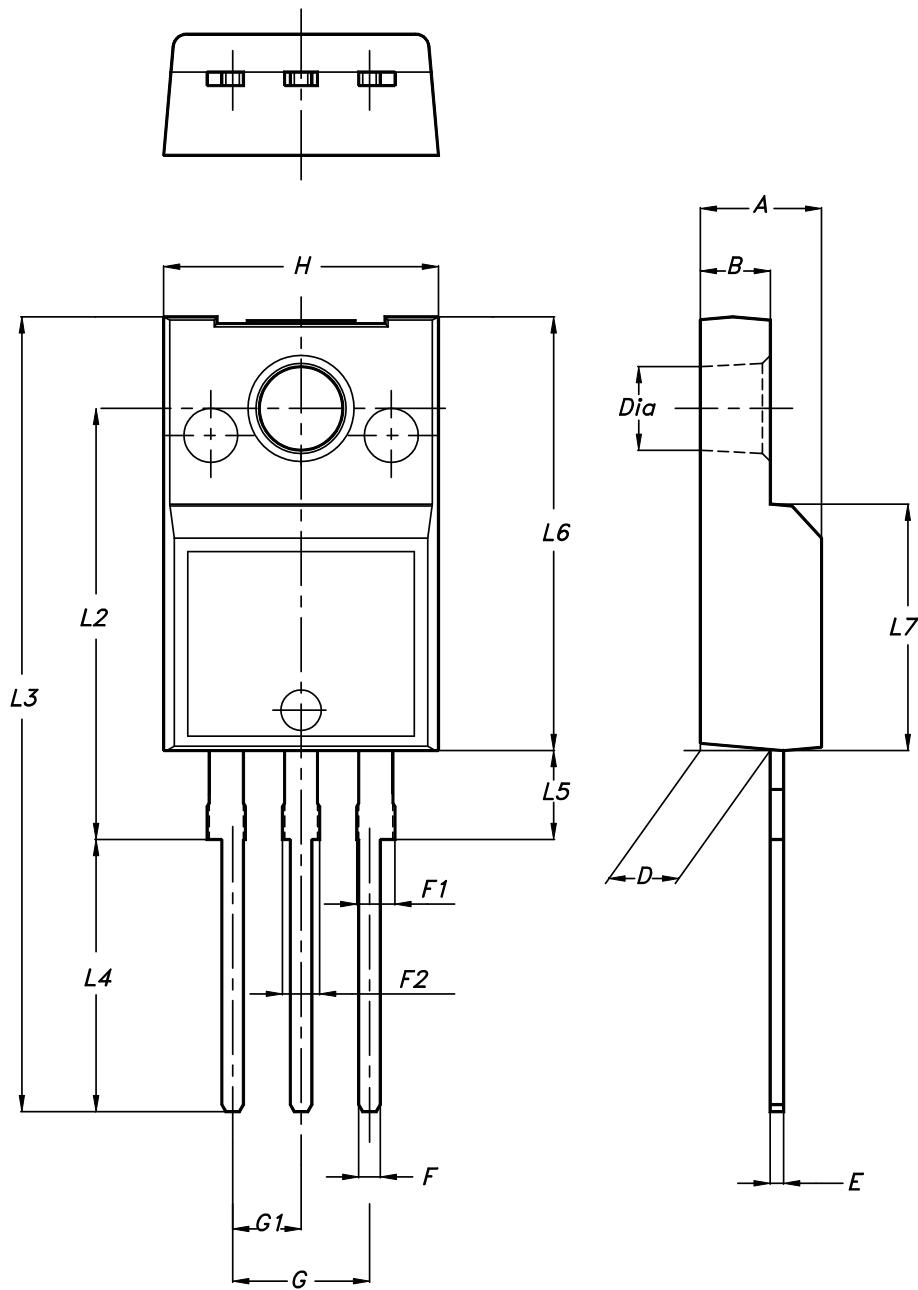
